

Primary Care – Routine care for established patients.

- Annual wellness visits and physicals
- General concerns
- Preventive screenings
- Coughs and colds
- Vaccinations
- Low cost labs, \$0 copayment

Nurse Line – Available when you have health care questions any time.

- Symptoms like a sore throat, muscle pain or a fever
- More information on a health issue

Virtual Visit – Consult with a board-certified doctor by phone, secure video or MDLIVE App – anytime, anywhere. Convenience from the comfort of home.

- Nausea or vomiting
- Rash
- Urinary problems
- Sinus Problems
- Ear problems
- Respiratory problems



Using Your Plan

The Right Care at the Right Time in the Right Place

Urgent Care – For an unexpected injury or illness that is not life threatening and you're unable to see your personal doctor quickly.

- Pink eye
- Non-anaphylactic allergic reactions
- Cuts requiring stitches

Emergency Care – When you have an illness, injury, symptom or condition so serious that a reasonable person would seek care right away to avoid serious harm.

- Chest pain
- Sudden numbness in an arm or leg
- Head or neck injury
- Trouble breathing

All Plans

- Added caregiver support benefit
- Added opioid treatment services
- Routine vision exam
- Routine dental care and fitness benefit on most plans
- Exceptional, local customer service
- Drug Plan: No deductible on Tiers 1, 2 and 3
 - ✓ Part D vaccinations (Shingrex) are predeductible



2020 Medicare Benefit Highlights

Northeast Wisconsin

Same cost share in- and out-of-network

Network Cares (PPO SNP)

- Specialized plan for Medicaid and Medicare dual-eligible
- Benefits designed to support additional needs
 - Home-delivered meals, non-emergency transportation, additional care management support, wellness rewards

Southeast Wisconsin

- Higher cost sharing out-of-network
- Out-of-network:
 - ✓ Part B drugs increasing to 50% coinsurance
 - ✓ Increased specialist cost shares

2020 Medicare Pharmacy Benefits

- \$0 deductible on Tiers 1, 2 and 3
- Tier 1 medication list expanded again (Tier 1 includes 218 medications)
- All vaccines on Tier 3
- Opioid tier change
 - ✓ Oxycontin moved to Tier 4
 - ✓ Oxycodone extended release to Tier 3
- Generic pain medications remain Tier 2
- Lantus preferred long acting insulin
- Coverage of Dexcom and Freestyle Libre at \$0 cost



What Else is New

Coordination of medical and pharmacy benefit

- Part B Step therapy
 - ✓ No intermingling of Part B and Part D Step therapy for 2020
 - ✓ Examples: Hyaluronic Acid Derivatives (HADs), Erythropoietin Stimulating Agents (ESAs), Infliximab products

Care Continuum

- Medical drug authorization since May 1, 2019 for prior authorization on select Part B medical drugs
- Providers receive medical drug prior authorizations within 5-10 minutes versus over three days
- First time Network Health is requiring prior authorization on some medical drugs (ex: Remicade)







Plan Benefit Changes

All IFP Plans

- Premiums reduced by 7 percent, on average
- Virtual visits are \$0 copayment or 0 percent coinsurance after deductible on HSA-qualified plans
- Lab tests are separated into two tiers
 - ✓ Lab tests for chronic condition management is \$0 copayment (0 percent coinsurance after deductible for HSA-qualified plans)
 - ✓ Diagnostic lab tests have a higher copayment
- Adherence generics lowered to a \$0 copayment
 - √ (0 percent coinsurance after deductible on HSA-qualified plans)
 - Includes certain categories of antidiabetics, statins and RAS antagonists



Available Plans

HMO – Health Maintenance Organization

- No out-of network benefits except for emergency
- Emergency and hospital-based urgent care claims will be paid at billed charges to avoid our members being balance billed

Traditional Copayment Plan

- First dollar (before deductible satisfied) coverage on copayments for some services.
 - ✓ Personal doctor visit
 - ✓ Certain medications generic and some brand drugs
 - ✓ Emergency room

Health Savings Account Qualified Plans

- Must be paired with a high deductible health plan (HDHP)
- Minimum embedded deductible of \$2,800 individual or \$5,600 family

networkhealth.com

 No first dollar coverage on HDHP plans except for preventive services and preventive drugs



Emergency Care



If a member has an emergency, we direct them to go to the nearest emergency facility to get the necessary care.

- Authorization is required for out-of-network follow-up care.
- If members don't know, we recommend contacting their personal doctor.



Marketplace Re-enrollment

2020 Open Enrollment Period

Runs from November 1 – December 15

- Members may active shop on Healthcare.gov or networkhealth.com to select a plan
- The Marketplace sends two notifications to existing members
 - ✓ Open Enrollment Notice
 - ✓ Issuer Notice

Automatic Re-enrollment

- Re-enrollment information is available on November 1, 2019, either on the Marketplace or in the member portal
- Members are automatically re-enrolled in the same plan if no action is taken by December 15

IFP Pharmacy Benefits

Pharmacy Benefits Manager (PBM) Change

January 1, 2020

- Commercial population (employer group and individual and family plans) switches from CVS/caremarkTM to Express Scripts[®] (ESI)
- ESI has been the PBM for our Medicare line of business since 2005
- Members can contact ESI to transition specialty and mail order medications



Pharmacy

Patient Assurance Program

Beginning January 1, 2020, Network Health is offering commercial members access to a new insulin program.

- Preferred brand (tier 3) insulin is available to members for a \$25 copayment for a 30-day supply.
- Insulin is being considered a preventive drug, which means HSAqualified plan members do not have to meet their deductible before they receive the \$25 copayment

Closed Formulary

- If a drug has a generic, only the generic is covered
- All plans have 6 tier formulary that includes low cost generics and offers benefits for non-preferred specialty drugs
