

SilverCloud is a leading mental and behavioral health online platform. It provides access to over 30 digital cognitive behavioral therapy



solutions. It supports the treatment of such conditions as depression, anxiety, dealing with chronic disease, insomnia, stress related to higher education, chronic

health and general well-being. You can access these programs independently or at the recommendation of your providers.



Pilot Programs

Network Health is always looking for ways to improve the health of our members. For State of Wisconsin members, we offer several pilot programs aimed at specific conditions. These pilot programs are not part of uniform benefits and are subject to change without notice.



Acupuncture Services Pilot Program

Network Health will cover 12 acupuncture visits with no cost sharing to you for the treatment of chronic headaches, chronic neck pain, chronic low back pain and osteoarthritis of the knee. Prior

authorization and a medical necessity review are required for coverage. If you have demonstrated improvement of your condition, we will cover an additional eight sessions. The additional visits will also need prior authorization. Please contact our member experience team with questions about the acupuncture benefit at 844-625-2208. For prior authorization requests, contact our utilization management department at 800-236-0208.



Prevent T2 Pilot Program

Our Prevent T2 Lifestyle Change Program is a yearlong program designed for people with prediabetes and who are at high risk for

type 2 diabetes and want to lower their risk. The program follows the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Guidelines. To be eligible for Prevent T2, you must have a fasting glucose of 100 - 125 mg/dL and a Body Mass Index (BMI) greater than 25. Evidenced Based Integrated Care Plan (EBICP) Pilot Program

Network Health, in partnership with Delta Dental, helps you access enhanced dental benefits available to members who are diabetic or are experiencing a high-risk pregnancy. Your Uniform Dental Benefit coverage allows for an additional cleaning as part of its Evidenced Based Integrated Care Plan (EBICP). ACCESS TO CARE 24/7

Sometimes, your personal doctor may be unavailable when you experience a non-emergency illness or issue. When this occurs, you can use our virtual visit provider network to get treatment over your phone, tablet or computer.



MDLIVE® Virtual Visits

As a Network Health member, you have access to virtual, online doctor visits through MDLIVE for your telehealth benefit. By using your phone, smartphone, tablet or computer, you can connect with a board-certified physician or pediatrician for treatment of a wide range of medical and behavioral health conditions. If a prescription is needed, you can take care of that as well.

Virtual visits are a convenient way to get care for covered health services including the diagnosis and treatment of non-emergency medical conditions. Virtual visits are designed as a convenient alternative to urgent care or personal doctor visits for non-emergency medical conditions.



Member Portal

Your member portal is the gateway to secure information about your Network Health plan. In it, you'll find links unique to you. You'll also find tools, tips and important information to help you

enhance your life, health and wellness.

When you sign in, you'll see a customized dashboard specific to you and your plan. From this dashboard, you can view benefit information, view out-ofpocket expenses, reorder an ID card, access plan materials and more. You can also select communication preferences, so you can choose to receive your Explanation of Benefits (EOB) statements by email instead of mail.

CARE MANAGEMENT

We offer care management services to support members who are transitioning from a hospital stay to home, and to those with complex medical or behavioral health needs and conditions such as cancer, end stage renal disease, organ transplant and traumatic injuries. We identify members who could benefit from services through claims, health risk assessment data, authorization data, and doctor or self-referrals.

Our experienced nurse and social work care managers help members through the following.

- · Developing customized care plans and goals
- Coordinating care with health care providers
- Facilitating access to care at the most appropriate care level
- Coordinating community resources
- Reviewing medications
- Explaining medical instructions
- Providing guidance on care and how to avoid problems
- Informing about signs indicating a condition is worsening and when to call the doctor
- Making follow-up calls so members know what to do, who to see and where to get the treatment needed
