



Breathe at Ease Program

Breathe at Ease is our proactive condition management program designed to help you avoid flare-ups, control symptoms and potentially improve your lung conditions. It's intended to supplement a physician's care of chronic bronchitis, emphysema and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD).

The program is conducted by a registered respiratory therapist (RRT) or certified respiratory therapist (CRT) from an outpatient pulmonary department. A telehealth option is also available. Once enrolled, you'll have a one-on-one meeting with a **Breathe At Ease** respiratory therapist and receive an assessment, discuss your health history and develop and action plan.

Prevent T2

Our Prevent T2 Lifestyle Change Program is a yearlong program designed for people with prediabetes who want to lower their risk of developing type 2 diabetes. Designed to help you make small changes that make a big

difference to your health, this proven program is facilitated by Network Health lifestyle coaches and is part of the National Diabetes Prevention Program.

To be eligible for Prevent T2, you must have a fasting glucose of 100 – 125 mg/dL and a Body Mass Index (BMI) greater than 25. If you'd like to learn more about Prevent T2, visit **networkhealth.com/wellness/prevent-t2** or email **NHpreventT2@networkhealth.com**.

MDLIVE® Telehealth Provider

As a Network Health member, you have access to virtual, online doctor visits through MDLIVE for your telehealth benefit. By using your phone, smartphone, tablet or computer, you can connect with a board-certified physician or pediatrician for treatment of a wide range of medical and behavioral health conditions.

Virtual visits are a convenient way to get care for covered health services including the diagnosis and treatment of non-emergency medical conditions. Virtual visits are designed as a convenient alternative to urgent care or personal doctor visits for non-emergency medical conditions.



Nurse Call Lines

Network Health partners with our health care systems that offer nurse lines. Visit **networkhealth.com/employer/etf/mdlive** for a current listing of provider nurse lines. You may also call your personal doctor's office directly.

When should you call the nurse line?

- When you have a symptom like a sore throat, muscle pain or a fever
- When you have questions about your medications or are prescribed a new medicine and want to know more about it
- When you want more information on a health issue
- When you need help determining where to go for care and it's not an emergency

Nurse lines are available 24/7, seven days a week.

WHERE TO GET CARE

Below are the differences between primary care, urgent care, virtual care and emergency care. The costs for each type of care are different. This is important to know, because emergency care can be much more costly. If your situation is not an emergency, you can keep your costs down by using other types of care.



Primary care

This is same-day or routine care for established patients. Areas of primary care

include the following.

- Annual wellness visits and physicals
- General concerns
- Coughs and colds
- Sore throats
- Vaccinations



Urgent Care

Urgent care is for an unexpected injury or illness that is not life threatening,

but still needs attention quickly so it doesn't develop into a serious problem. Areas of urgent care include the following.

- Fever
- Pink eye
- Cuts requiring stitches
- Vomiting
- Sinus infections
- Allergic reactions



Virtual Care

Virtual visits, offered through MDLIVE®, are a convenient way to get care for covered

health services that include the diagnosis and treatment of medical conditions through electronic means. MDLIVE is designed as an alternative to urgent care visits for non-emergency medical conditions.



Emergency Care

An emergency is an illness, injury, symptom or condition so serious, that a reasonable


person would seek care right away to avoid serious harm. Emergency care conditions include the following.

- Chest pain
- Sudden numbness in an arm or leg
- Trouble breathing
- Head or neck injury
