ENROLLMENT REQUEST FORM TO ENROLL IN A MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLAN**Who can use this form?**

People with Medicare who want to join a Medicare Advantage Plan

To join a plan, you must:

- Be a United States citizen or be lawfully present in the U.S.
- Live in the plan's service area

Important: To join a Medicare Advantage plan, you must also have both:

- Medicare Part A (Hospital Insurance)
- Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance)

When do I use this form?

You can join a plan:

- Between October 15–December 7 each year (for coverage starting January 1)
- Within 3 months of first getting Medicare
- In certain situations where you're allowed to join or switch plans

Visit www.Medicare.gov to learn more about when you can sign up for a plan.

What do I need to complete this form?

- Your Medicare Number (the number on your red, white, and blue Medicare card)
- Your permanent address and phone number

Note: You must complete all items in Section 1. The items in Section 2 are optional — you can't be denied coverage because you don't fill them out.

Reminders:

- If you want to join a plan during fall open enrollment (October 15–December 7), the plan must get your completed form by December 7.
- Your plan will send you a bill for the plan's premium. You can choose to sign up to have your premium payments deducted from your bank account or your monthly Social Security (or Railroad Retirement Board) benefit.

Paying Your Plan Premium

If we determine you owe a late enrollment penalty, (or if you currently have a late enrollment penalty), we need to know how you would prefer to pay it. You can pay by mail or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) each month. You can also choose to pay your premium by automatic deduction from your Social Security or Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) benefit check each month.

You can pay your monthly plan premium (including any late enrollment penalty that you currently have or may owe) by mail or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) each month. You can also choose to pay your premium by automatic deduction from your Social Security or Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) benefit check each month.

If you are assessed a Part D-Income Related Monthly Adjustment Amount, you will be notified by the Social Security Administration. You will be responsible for paying this extra amount in addition to your plan premium. You will either have the amount withheld from your Social Security benefit check or be billed directly by Medicare or RRB. DO NOT pay Network Health Medicare Advantage Plans the Part D-IRMAA.

People with limited incomes may qualify for Extra Help to pay for their prescription drug costs. If eligible, Medicare could pay for 75 percent or more of your drug costs including monthly prescription drug premiums, annual deductibles, and coinsurance. Additionally, those who qualify will not be subject to the coverage gap or a late enrollment penalty. Many people are eligible for these savings and don't even know it. You can also apply for Extra Help online at www.socialsecurity.gov/prescriptionhelp.

If you qualify for Extra Help with your Medicare prescription drug coverage costs, Medicare will pay all or part of your plan premium. If Medicare pays only a portion of this premium, we will bill you for the amount that Medicare doesn't cover.

If you don't select a payment option, you will get a bill each month. **Please select a premium payment option.**

Get a bill each month. Between the 15th and 20th of each month, we will send you a billing statement indicating your balance due.

If you currently have health coverage from an employer or union, joining a Network Health Medicare Advantage Plan could affect your employer or union health benefits. You could lose your employer or union health coverage if you join a Network Health Medicare Advantage Plan. Read the communications your employer or union sends you. If there isn't any information on whom to contact, your benefits administrator or the office that answers questions about your coverage can help.

IMPORTANT: Please Read and Sign Below**By completing this enrollment application, I agree to the following.**

Network Health Insurance Corporation is a Medicare Advantage plan and has a contract with the federal government. I will need to keep my Medicare Parts A and B. I can only be in one Medicare Advantage plan at a time and I understand that my enrollment in this plan will automatically end my enrollment in another Medicare health plan or prescription drug plan. It is my responsibility to inform you of any prescription drug coverage that I have or may get in the future. I understand that if I don't have Medicare prescription drug coverage, or creditable prescription drug coverage (as good as Medicare's), I may have to pay a late enrollment penalty if I enroll in Medicare prescription drug coverage in the future. Enrollment in this plan is generally for the entire year. Once I enroll, I may leave this plan or make changes only at certain times of the year when an enrollment period is available (example: October 15 – December 7, of every year), or under certain special circumstances. Network Health Medicare Advantage Plans serve a specific service area. If I move out of the area that Network Health Medicare Advantage Plans serve, I need to notify the plan so I can disenroll and find a new plan in my new area. Once I am a member of a Network Health Medicare Advantage Plan, I have the right to appeal plan decisions about payment or services if I disagree. I will read the *Evidence of Coverage* document from Network Health Medicare Advantage Plan when I get it to know which rules I must follow to get coverage with this Medicare Advantage plan. I understand that people with Medicare aren't usually covered under Medicare while out of the country except for limited coverage near the U.S. border.

I understand that beginning on the date Network Health Medicare Advantage Plan coverage begins, I must get all off my health care from my Network Health Medicare Advantage Plan, and using services in-network can cost less than using services out-of-network, except for emergency or urgently needed services or out-of-area dialysis services. If medically necessary, Network Health Medicare Advantage Plan provides refunds for all covered benefits, even if I get services out-of-network. Services authorized by Network Health Medicare Advantage Plans and other services contained in my Network Health Medicare Advantage Plan *Evidence of Coverage* document (also known as a member contract or subscriber agreement) will be covered. Without authorization, **NEITHER MEDICARE NOR NETWORK HEALTH MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLANS WILL PAY FOR THE SERVICES.**

I understand that if I am getting assistance from a sales agent, broker, or other individual employed by or contracted with Network Health Medicare Advantage Plans, he/she may be paid based on my enrollment in a Network Health Medicare Advantage Plan.

Release of Information: By joining this Medicare health plan, I acknowledge that Network Health Medicare Advantage Plans will release my information to Medicare and other plans as is necessary for treatment, payment and health care operations. I also acknowledge that Network Health Medicare Advantage Plan will release my information, including my prescription drug event data, to Medicare, who may release it for research and other purposes which follow all applicable federal statutes and regulations.
